What is required to be a successful SBAT

- ✓ Completion of 100 days in the workplace over the training period, usually 1 day per week.
- ✓ Dedication and commitment to your study, not only in school but after hours and on weekends. We recommend 6-10 hours per week dedicated to your Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care learning and assessment in addition to your 1 day per week in the workplace.
- ✓ Satisfactory completion of all assessment activities.
